





INVITATION

We, boxing club "IN-FIGHT" and Latvian Boxing Federation, are proud to invite boxers and their team delegates to our annual international boxing tournament

4rd Riga Ladies Boxing Cup 2023,
which will be held on 8st – 13th of MARCH 2023 in Riga, Latvia.

1 PURPOSE AND TARGET OF THE EVENT:

→ The purpose of the tournament is to popularize and develop boxing in Riga, also to cultivate healthy lifestyle among young people. And the targets are: promotion and improving boxers' skills, strengthening friendly and sporting relations between representatives of clubs from different countries.

→ Maximum of participants in each weight category is 8 boxers.

③ COMPETITION FORMAT:

→ The tournament is held in accordance with valid international IBA rules.

6 REGISTRATION:

- → Registration to the tournament opens on 16th of January 2023.
- → Final entries with arrival and departure details must be sent until 25th February, 2023.
- → Registration of participants is performed by filling the form at <u>registration.in-fight.lv/</u>, there you can also see the list of already registered.

(7) REQUIREMENTS:

- → All Boxers must bring the following items:
 - IBA International Record Book;
 - Current and valid Passport;
 - Declaration of non-pregnancy;
 - Medical admission to the tournament from the attending physician or medical institution with a mark in the record book (must not be older than 3 months);
 - Two sets of uniform (blue and red);
 - Also a mesh or shawl/bandanna, for use under a protective helmet.
- → Boxing gloves and safety helmet complying with IBA Technical and Competition Rules are provided by the organizer.

8 ACCREDITATION & ACCOMMODATION:

Each participant (as well as the coach/referee/judge or other participant of the official delegation) must pay a fee of:

- → TWIN ROOMS 40 €/pers. for each day of the competition. This amount includes accommodation for 1 participant including breakfast and wi-fi.
- → SINGLE ROOMS 65 €/pers. for each day of the competition. This amount includes accommodation for 1 participant including breakfast and wi-fi.
- → Unfortunately, we are obliged to inform participants that this year we cannot include lunch and dinner in the price of accommodation. Team members must take care of their meals themselves.

- → Transfer of participants and teams from the airport upon arrival and to the airport upon departure will be provided for a separate fee of 25 €/pers.
- → All costs associated with the flight or transportation of teams to the city of the tournament are covered by the delegating party. As well as the costs associated with health insurance, etc.

(9) MEDICAL CARE:

→ Will be provided by tournament organizers (as well as the ambulance brigade).

10 MEDALS:

- → The winner in each age group and each weight category will be awarded with a gold medal. The runner-up finalist gets a silver medal. Both athletes retired in the semifinals will be awarded with a bronze medals.
- → Also, the organizers announce 3 nominations outside the categories "For the Best Technique", "For the Will to Win", "The Most Beautiful Fight". The winners will be determined by interviewing the opinions of the representatives of the teams and the main jury and will be awarded with a separate prize.

(11) COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS:

When issuing this Invitation there is no Covid-19 restrictions in Latvia. 4th Riga Ladies Boxing Cup is therefore not applying Covid-19 protocol. As Tournament LOC is constantly monitoring this situation we shall keep all participants updated of any changes that may occur.
