



The Polish Boxing Association has the great pleasure to invite your national team to participate in the **XXXVIII Feliks Stamm International Boxing Tournament** for Elite Men and Women which will be held from **May 21 to May 27 2023** in Pułtusk.

The finals will be broadcast by Polish National Television with possibility of transmit the signal to other countries.

FELIKS STAMM

Feliks Stamm is a historical figure, almost a cult figure in the world of sport. Creator of the Polish school of boxing. A coach whose authority and achievements were admired by the whole world, and by numerous pupils simply called "Papa". To commemorate the great trainer and educator of generations of boxers, the Polish Boxing Association decided to establish an international tournament named after him. The first in the series took place in November 1977. Today it is one of the most important Olympic boxing events, as evidenced not only by the interest of clubs from around the world in participating in it, but also by the fact that this event has been permanently included in the calendar of the World Boxing Federation IBA

PUŁTUSK

Pułtusk is abeautiful historical city distant from Warsaw by 1 hour drive. Located on the Narew River, it boasts the longest market square in Europe. It has many unique monuments attracting crowds of tourists. Its beauty was also appreciated by filmmakers - the city was an inspiration for many directors who created their film sets here.

1. RULES – IBA for ELITE:

Age Classification:	The competition is open for Elite boxers (Men and Women) aged of 19 to 40 according to their year of birth.
Weight Categories:	Men - <u>13</u> weight categories - 46-48kg, 51kg, 54 kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63,5kg, 67kg, 71kg, 75kg, 80kg, 86kg, 92kg, +92kg
	Women - <u>12</u> weight categories – 45-48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 81kg, +81 kg.

NUMBER OF ROUNDS:

MEN: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds. WOMEN: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds.

SCORING SYSTEM:

IBA Scoring System, the "Ten Point Must-System", will be used.

2. BOXING EQUIPMENT:

LOC will provide licensed boxing gloves to all Boxers for all Bouts. The gloves are compulsory official items which all Boxers must wear, as they will not be allowed to wear their personal ones.

- 10 oz Gloves will be used from Light Flyweight category (46-48kg) to Light Welterweight category (67kg),
- 12 oz Gloves will be used from Welterweight category (71kg) to Super Heavyweight category (92+ kg).

For Men: No headguards will be used according to the IBA Rules.

For Women: LOC will provide licensed headguards to all Women Boxers for all Bouts.











3. REQUIREMENTS:

BOXERS:

Each Boxer must have up to date IBA Record Book along with annual medical certificate.

Each Boxer must have two sets of uniform (red and blue color sets) approved by IBA.

Women Boxers must mandatory bring an IBA Declaration of Non-pregnancy (pgs. 42-43 of the IBA AOB Competition Rules – available on the IBA website).

COACHES:

All Coaches must be IBA Certified Coaches (IBA 1, 2, or 3 Stars) and registered in the IBA Database as LOC will check each Coach's status at the time of registration. Without the appropriate IBA certification, coaches will not be allowed to enter this competition.

REFEREES & JUDGES:

R&J are sent by National Federations (IBA 1, 2, or 3 Stars). Each R&J must have his/her IBA Record Book as well as up to date medical examinations.

Each Team Delegation must bring national flag 1 x 1,5 m and anthem on MP3 or CD.

MEDALS:

The LOC will provide medals, diplomas and special prizes for each Men and Women weight category:

1st Place: gold medal 2nd Place: silver medal 3rd Place: bronze medal 4th Place: bronze medal

4. COMPOSITION OF THE OFFICIAL DELEGATION:

1-2 boxers – 2 coaches + 1 medical + 1 IBA R/J + 1 official

3-4 boxers - 3 coaches + 1 medical + 1 IBA R/J + 1 official

5-9 boxers – 4 coaches + 1 medical + 1 IBA R/J + 1 official

10-15 boxers – 5 coaches + 1 medical + 1 IBA R/J + 1 official


