3. COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The event is approved as professional sport event with a very strict countermeasure concept and if required, the EUBC Event Management Protocol for COVID-19 will be implemented according to the current COVID-19 situation in the Host City at the time of the Championships. There will be an update regarding all the requirements and protocols to be followed.

4. COMPETITION REGULATIONS and OFFICIALS

4.1. Regulations

- The Championships will be organized based on IBA Technical & Competition Rules.
- The Official Draw will be conducted by IBA Approved Scoring System through an electronic draw.

4.2 Competition Officials

• The Technical Delegate of the event is Mr. Adam Kusior.





 This Championships is a Continental, IBA-sanctioned Event and will be officiated by IBA-certified International Technical Officials and IBA-certified 1-Star to 3-Star Referees & Judges.

5. EVENT SCHEDULE

5.1 Event Period

The event dates are 15th August to 26th August 2023, and the schedule will include the following:

- Arrivals
- Sport Entries Check
- Technical Meeting and Official Draw
- Opening Ceremony
- Competition Period
- Departures

15 August 15 and 16 August –TBD 16 August - TBD 17 August - TBD 17 – 25 August 26 August

NOTE: The above schedule is tentative and subject to change. The final schedule with dates and times will be decided accordingly with the Technical Delegate and LOC, and all Teams will be notified.

TRAINING: Teams will be given a schedule for training times at the Official Training Venue. They will be allowed to train ONLY during the period that they have been assigned. The Schedule will be posted on the Information Board at Team Hotels & Coaches will be informed.

6. REGISTRATIONS

6.1 Boxers

Schoolboys and Schoolgirls boxers between the ages of 13 and 14 (based on the year of birth -2009 & 2010) are eligible for this Championships.

Only one boxer per National Federation per weight category will be allowed to compete. National Federations may register a maximum of one main boxer and up to two reserve boxers for each of the weight categories listed below:

<u>Schoolboys (16)</u>: 37 – 40 kg, 42 kg, 44 kg, 46 kg, 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63 kg, 66 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 90 kg.

<u>Schoolgirls</u> (13): 34 – 36 kg, 38 kg, 40 kg, 42 kg, 44 kg, 46 kg, 48 kg, 51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 64 kg, 70 kg.

Nominating reserve boxers is strongly encouraged to allow an option of substituting boxers prior to the Sport Entries Check without penalties.

6.2 Team Officials

Each Team Delegation can register the following number of Team Officials:

- 2 Team Managers (1 for girls, 1 for boys)





- 1 Team Doctor
- 1 Physiotherapist (1 for girls, 1 for boys)
- 1 IBA Certified Team Cut Technician
- Number of coaches according to the table below:
 - $\circ~$ 1–3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches
 - $\circ~$ 4–8 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches
 - $\circ~9-13$ Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches
 - \circ 13 29 Boxers: Up to 10 Coaches

6.2.1 Coaches

• Only IBA certified coaches (1, 2 or 3 star) can be registered as a Coach for this Championships. National Level coaches (not certified by IBA) are not allowed to serve as seconds and can only be registered as Extra Persons.

If your Team Delegation does not have an IBA Certified coach (1, 2 or 3 star), please raise this issue at the Technical Meeting, so arrangements can be made with another team.

- Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) coaches. However,only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.
- One of the 3 coaches can be replaced by an IBA Certified Team Cut Technician.

6.3 Extra Persons – Team official (to work with the team)

Each National Federation has the possibility to register <u>up to two</u> additional extra team officials. Extra Officials will have access to Team Stands and Training Venue, but will NOT have access to warm-up areas in the Competition Venue and will NOT be allowed to serve as seconds. Extra team officials must be accommodated in the team hotels in order to be accredited.

It is the responsibility of respective National Delegations to ensure that all Team Delegations Members hold the required certification and are qualified to perform their duties.

6.4 Extra Persons - National Federation Representatives (President, Secretary General, etc.) or VIPs

Each team must inform the LOC (<u>boksarskainfo@gmail.com</u>) and EUBC Office (<u>office@eubcboxing.org</u>) about any national federation representatives or VIPS who will attend the Championships on behalf of the NF.





6.5 Process and deadlines

Registration will open on 24th June 2023

6.6 Appointment of R&Js

must be nominated by National Federations. Each National Federation must nominate an **IBA-certified 1-, 2-, or 3-star** Referee & Judge and send the name of the candidate to EUBC Office at <u>office@eubcboxing.org</u> no later than on **July 15, 2023 (23:59 GMT)**. Please be informed that the nominated R&Js will be subject to confirmation by the EUBC R&J Committee and the IBA R&J Committee. In case of any issue regarding the R&J's appointment, EUBC will contact National Federations in order to appoint a replacement. It is **mandatory** for all Team Delegations to bring an accompanying qualified IBA R&J.

6.7 Late registration fees

Please note, that EUBC has introduced a system of fines in order to support the organizers of Continental Championships and ensure timely submission of all registration information. EUBC encourages all National Federations to plan timely and diligently to avoid these fines.

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7. ACCREDITATIONS

All Team Delegation members registered for the event through the IBA Database within the deadline will receive their accreditations on site after the LOC has approved the accommodation payment.

All photos must be sent to the LOC by 01st August for preparation of the Accreditations. Please contact (boksarskainfo@gmail.com) Accreditations will be given out only upon presentation of a passport.

The Accreditation Center will be located at the Pohorje Village Resort Hotel.

8. SPORT ENTRIES CHECK

The Sport Entries Check will take place on 15 and 16 August, at the Pohorje Village Resort Hotel. Please make sure to arrive in Maribor, Slovenia, on or prior to 15 August. EUBC and LOC will inform Team Delegations of their exact appointment time prior to the event (the schedule will also be displayed at Team Delegation Information Desks). The Sport Entries Check is **mandatory** for all Team Delegations, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to attend their appointment on time.

Each Team delegation can appoint a maximum of 2 persons to attend the Sport Entries Check. EUBC recommends to each team to send the Team Manager and/or the Team Doctor and/or the Head Coach.

Each Team Delegation's representatives will have an appointment with the Officials to confirm the entry list of their delegation, the spelling of boxers' names, the uniforms, national flag, and anthem and to present the official documents listed below.

Your representative(s) must present:

- 1. National Passports of each boxer.
- 2. Record Books of each boxer (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- 3. Results of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV tests, not older than 6 months
- 4. IBA Medical certificates issued within the last 30 days for each boxer.
- 5. Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form for each female boxer, signed and dated
- 6. Video consent form signed by team manager/head coach.
- 7. Code of Conduct signed by team manager/head coach.
- 8. Boxer's uniform examples.

To complete the Sport Entries process and receive accreditations, all Team





Delegations must have fully paid the LOC for their accommodation.

<u>NOTE</u>

The EUBC Office will send all Sport Entries Check forms to National Federations

IMPORTANT

- Please note that the presence of your representative is mandatory. In the event where Team Delegation Representatives do not show-up to the scheduled appointment, the entire Team will be disqualified.

Competitors attending the training camp will receive 5 Euros discount per day throughout their stay for the entire Championships.

Video recording of bouts by Team Delegation Members for broadcasting purposes of any kind (including social media) will not be allowed.

National Federations may be allowed to record bouts of their boxers with not more than one camera per ring, exclusively for technical purposes. Specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose. Each National Federation must submit a signed copy of the Video Consent Form at the Sport Entries Check.
