3. DISCLAIMER

Disclaimer regarding damages/inappropriate behaviour by Team Delegations at EUBC-Sanctioned events

The EUBC and the Host National Federation/Local Organizing Committee of the EUBC Championships will not tolerate any misconduct, damages, or inappropriate actions committed by any member of Team Delegations.

Previous EUBC Championships have experienced certain regrettable incidents by certain individuals belonging to team delegations, especially of young age, which resulted in damages to properties and disrespect to hotel staff.

The EUBC and LOCs rely on the National Federations participating at the Championships to ensure that their delegations will follow all basic rules of behaviour and respect.

The EUBC and the LOC would like to remind National Federations that they (the NFs) will be held accountable and responsible for any damages caused by their Team Delegation to the properties of the hotel, venue and any facilities of the Championships. The EUBC Code of Conduct is in effect for all EUBC Championships and where necessary, Article 7 will be activated.







4. COMPETITION REGULATIONS AND OFFICIALS

4.1 Regulations

The Championships will be organized based on IBA Technical & Competition Rules.

The Official Draw will be conducted by IBA Approved Scoring System through an electronic draw.

4.2 Competition Officials

The Technical Delegate of the event is Mr. Viorel Sima.

This Championships is an EUBC-sanctioned Event and will be officiated by IBA-certified International Technical Officials and IBA 3-star Referees/Judges.

5. EVENT SCHEDULE

5.1 Event Period

The event dates are 15 - 29 April 2024 and the schedule will include the following:

Arrivals & Sport Entries	15.04.2024.
Sport Entries Check	16.04 – 17.04.2024.
Technical Meeting & Official Draw	17.04.2024.
Opening Ceremony	18.04.2024.
Competition Period	18.0428.04.2024 (Rest day 26 April)
Departures**	29.04.2024.

** Departures - as scheduled – teams will be informed of departure time from hotel.

NOTE: The final schedule with dates and times will be decided accordingly with the Technical Delegate and LOC, and all Teams will be notified.

TRAINING: The training venue will be available from 10.04.2024. Teams will be given a schedule for training times at the Official Training Venue. They will be allowed to train ONLY during the period that they have been assigned. The Schedule will be posted on the Information Board at Team Hotels, and Coaches will be informed.







6. PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be given to Boxers earning 1st to 5th place according to the following criteria:

- a. The boxer will be entitled to receive the Prize Money **only** if he/she has won at least one bout (including by walkover) at the Competition;
- b. Prize money shall be paid according to article 1.7 of the IBA Technical and Competitions Rules;
- c. Prize money shall be paid exclusively in the United States Dollars (USD) currency;
- d. Prize money shall be paid by wire transfer to each eligible boxer's bank account;
- e. The sum listed in the table below is the gross amount to paid to each eligible boxer and EUBC will not be held liable for costs related to exchange rate costs, bank costs and commissions, etc.;
- f. Any taxes and duties which might arise in connection with the Prize Money shall be covered by boxer at their own expense.
- g. Boxer must provide all the respective bank details for transfer within 14 days after end of the Competition and provide any further information requested by EUBC Finance Department/EUBC Office.
- h. The processing of payment of prize money will begin two months after the end of the Championships providing all criteria have been satisfied.

Prize money will be given for the following placing in the 13 men weight categories and the 12 women weight classes according to the criteria listed above:

7. REGISTRATIONS

7.1 Boxers

Only one boxer per National Federation per weight category will be allowed to compete. National Federations may register a maximum of one main boxer and up to two reserve boxersfor each of the weight categories listed below:

All registrations must be done through the IBA database (<u>https://iba-database.sport/nf</u>)

Entering reserve boxers in the database is strongly encouraged to allow an option of substituting boxers prior to the Sport Entries Check without penalties.

7.2 Team Officials

Each Team Delegation can register the following number of Team Officials:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Doctor
- 1 Physiotherapist
- 1 IBA Certified Team Cut Technician

Number of coaches according to the table below:

- o 1 3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches
- o 4 8 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches
- o 9 13 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches
- o 14 25 Boxers: Up to 10 Coaches







7.3 Coaches

Only IBA certified coaches (1, 2 or 3 star) can be registered as a Coach for this event. National Level coaches (not certified by IBA) are not allowed to serve as seconds and can only be registered as Extra Persons.

If your Team Delegation does not have an IBA Certified coach (1, 2 or 3 star), please raise this issue at the Technical Meeting, so arrangements can be made with another team.

Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) coaches. However, only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) mayenter the ring.

One of the 3 coaches can be replaced by an IBA Certified Team Cut Technician.

7.4 Extra Team Officials (to work with the team)

Each National Federation has the possibility to register **up to two** additional extra team officials. Extra Team Officials will have access to Team Stands and Training Venue, but will NOT have access to warm-up areas in the Competition Venue and will NOT be allowed to serve asseconds. Extra team officials must be accommodated in the team hotels in order to be accredited.

It is the responsibility of respective National Delegations to ensure that all Team Delegations Members hold the required certification and are qualified to perform their duties.

7.5 National Federation Representatives (President, Secretary General, etc.) or VIPs

Each team must inform the LOC(<u>accomodationep2024@gmail.com</u>) and EUBC Office (<u>office@eubcboxing.org</u>) about any national federation representatives or VIPS who will attend the Championships on behalf of the NF.

7.6 Process and deadlines

Registration will open on 14 February 2024 and end on 05 March 2024.

All registrations for Team Delegations will have to completed through the IBA database(<u>https://iba-database.sport/nf</u>)

7.7 Late registration fees

Late registrations will be considered only on a case by case basis and **the fines will be in effect.**

Please note, that EUBC has introduced a system of fines in order to support the organizers of EUBC Competitions and ensure timely submission of all registration information. EUBC encourages all National Federations to plan timely and diligently to avoid these fines. All fines WILL BE IN EFFECT for the Championships.

8. ACCREDITATIONS

All Team Delegation members registered for the event through the IBA Database within the deadline will receive their accreditations on site after payment of accommodation is confirmed.

All photos must be sent to the LOC for preparation of the Accreditations. Please contact <u>mpopadic@gmail.com</u>





Accreditations will be given out only upon presentation of a passport. The Accreditation Center will be located at the Hotel Jugoslavija.

9. SPORT ENTRIES CHECK

The Sport Entries Check will take place on 16.04 – 17.04.2024. at the Hotel Jugoslavija. Please make sure to arrive in Belgrade, Serbia on or prior to 16 April. EUBC and LOC will inform Team Delegations of their exact appointment time prior to the event (the schedule will also be displayed at Team Delegation Information Desks). The Sport Entries Check is **mandatory** for all Team Delegations, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to attend their appointment on time.

Each Team delegation can appoint a maximum of 2 persons to attend the Sport Entries Check.

Each Team Delegation's representatives will have an appointment with the Officials to confirm the entry list of their delegation, the spelling of boxers' names, the uniforms, national flag & anthem and to present the official documents listed below.

Your representative(s) must present:

- National Passports of each boxer
- Record Books of each boxer (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- Results of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV tests, not older than 6 months
- Declaration of non-pregnancy (females)
- IBA Medical certificates issued within the last 30 days for each boxer.
- Anti-doping consent forms signed by each boxer.
- Video consent form signed by team manager/head coach.
- Code of Conduct Enforcement signed by team manager/head coach.
- Boxer's uniform examples.

To complete the Sport Entries process and receive accreditations, all Team Delegations must pay accommodation costs in full.

- Please note that the presence of your representative is mandatory. In the event where Team Delegation Representatives do not show-up to the scheduled appointment, the entire Team will be disqualified.

15. IMAGE RIGHTS & TECHNICAL VIDEO RECORDING

A Host Broadcaster will film promotional videos and official event photographers will take photos of boxers before and during the Championships. All training sessions will be open to the media. By participating in the Event, each Team Delegation Member agrees to release his/her image rights to EUBC.

Video recording of bouts by Team Delegation Members for broadcasting purposes of any kind(including social media) will not be allowed.

National Federations may be allowed to record bouts of their boxers with not more than one camera per ring, exclusively for technical purposes. Specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose. Each National Federation must submit a signed copy of the Video Consent Form at the Sport Entries Check.

16. DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping controls will be conducted in accordance with the IBA Anti-Doping Rules and theWorld Anti-Doping Code. We want to remind you that according to WADA regulations, from 2016, blood testing may be conducted during IBA Competitions.

TUE must be submitted through the ADAMS system no later than the 15 March 2024

17. MEDICAL CARE

The LOC will provide medical care and first-aid during the entire Championships Period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the Championships.
