



EUBC Competitions Classification & Organizational Guidelines

(Effective 01st January 2024)

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Introduction



EUBC Competitions refer to:

1. EUBC Championships
2. EUBC-Sanctioned Events (eg. International Tournaments)

The present guidelines, effective January 1, 2024, shall apply to EUBC Championships and EUBC sanctioned events included in the EUBC Calendar

EUBC-Sanctioned Event Categories



Category A – International Tournaments that has participation of 15 and more Team Delegations

Category B – International Tournaments that has participation of 3 to 14 Team Delegations

Note: Events that have less than 3 team delegations will not be eligible to be considered as an EUBC-Sanctioned event

Application Process – EUBC Championships



- NF must submit Letter of Interest and Bidding Proposal when EUBC provides Bidding Guidelines and requests applications.
- The Hosts of the EUBC Championships are decided by vote of the EUBC Board of Directors.

Application Process – EUBC-Sanctioned Events



- NFs must provide their yearly Calendar to the EUBC Office when requested to do so (usually the 4th quarter of the preceding year).
- NF must receive approval from EUBC to host an EUBC-Sanctioned Event prior to announcing the event to EUBC/IBA NFs.

If a Boxing Club wants to organize an EUBC-Sanctioned event, (International Tournament or Training Camp), then the following procedure MUST be followed:

1. The club must first inform their respective National Federation and gain its approval
2. The National Federation must then communicate with EUBC to gain approval as an EUBC-Sanctioned event

Application Process – EUBC-Sanctioned Events

Requirements:



- NF agrees to abide by EUBC and IBA rules and guidelines.
- NF agrees to display the EUBC logo/brand on the Event material, including the invitation, scoring documents, at the venue, event hotel, etc.
- NF agrees to pay the Host Fee within one week after the end of the event.
- The NF agrees that EUBC Competition Committee will appoint a Technical Delegate to oversee the event.
- The registration of teams to the EUBC-Sanctioned Tournaments must be managed **only** through the participating National Federations.
- Host NF shall accept entries submitted only by National Federations, or in the case of IBA-Neutral boxers, Host NF accepts entries made by IBA.

Application Process – EUBC-Sanctioned Events



Requirements regarding Technical Delegate:

The Host NF is responsible to cover expenses associated with the Technical Delegate appointed for the International Tournament including the following:

- Per diem – must be paid from the arrival day to the departure day
- Accommodation and Meals
- Transport expenses: flight tickets with hand luggage and one piece of checked luggage; train or bus tickets and any other valid costs related to the Technical Delegate's travel

Application Process – EUBC-Sanctioned Events



- NF agrees that only if the host meets the requirements of an EUBC-Sanctioned Tournament, then the event will be added and advertised on the EUBC Calendar, and the host will have the license to qualify the tournament
- If not, the host has no right to use the EUBC property rights, example, the logo.

Payment of Host Fees



EUBC Championships – Host Fees must be paid before the start of the championships as prescribed in the the Host City Agreement.

EUBC-Sanctioned Events – Host fees must be paid within one week after the end of the event.

Entry VISA requirement for the bidders of EUBC Championships



Whereas (i) with the adoption of the Constitution at the Extraordinary Congress of Istanbul (July 2023), the EUBC has endorsed the principle of political neutrality (Art. 3.2.i of the Constitution)

Whereas (ii) it is a contractual obligation of the Host NF of EUBC Championships (Art. 10.4 template Host City Agreement) to “*undertake all the necessary measures to ensure that all participants at the Championship receive an entry visa, without any discrimination and regardless of the status of diplomatic relationship between involved countries*”

any bidder of EUBC Championships who believe that it might experience some problems and/or restrictions with the grant of visas for any team delegation, must inform the BoD in advance before the end of the bidding process

Accommodation & Meals deposit at EUBC Championships and EUBC-Sanctioned Events

Due to difficulties faced by LOCs in the past with no-shows and frequent/last-minute changes in team delegation compositions, the EUBC Board of Directors has approved and encourages LOCs to request non-refundable accommodation & meals deposits to be paid via bank transfer by participating National Federations prior to the event.

Competition Registration-related Financial Penalties

Incorrect registration – Registration of athletes not carried out according to the Rules	€1000	€1000	Applicable to the Host for accepting entry that is not from a National Federation

Disclaimer regarding inappropriate behavior and damages caused by Team Delegations at EUBC Championships



Attention: National Federations, Coaches, Team Managers, Officials and Boxers

The EUBC and the Host National Federation/Local Organizing Committee of the EUBC Championships will not tolerate any misconduct, damages, or inappropriate actions committed by any member of Team Delegations.

The EUBC and LOCs rely on the National Federations participating at the Championships to ensure that their delegations follow all basic rules of proper behaviour.

Previous EUBC Championships have experienced regrettable incidents by team delegation members, especially of young age, which resulted in damages to properties and disrespect to hotel staff.

The EUBC and the LOC would like to remind National Federations that they (NFs) will be held accountable and responsible for any damages caused by their Team Delegation to the properties of the hotel, venue and any facilities of the Championships.

The EUBC Code of Conduct is in effect for all EUBC Championships and where necessary, Article 7 will be enforced.

Registration Process (Team Delegations)



EUBC Championships:

Via IBA Database

EUBC-Sanctioned Events:

Team delegations must be registered **ONLY** by their respective National Federation for an event. In addition to the Excel Registration Form, participating NFs must also sign and stamp their team's registration list and provide to the Host NF.

The Host NFs must ensure that all team delegations' registrations are valid.

Rules effective from:



- The guidelines herein are applicable from January 01st 2024
- A review will be made during the fourth quarter of 2024
