I have the distinct honor to greet you on the upcoming EUBC European Boxing Championships for schoolboys and schoolgirls in Zlatibor, Serbia.



## 3. COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The event is approved as professional sport event with a very strict countermeasure concept and if required, the EUBC Event Management Protocol for COVID-19 will be implemented according to the current COVID-19 situation in the Host City at the time of the Championships. There will be an update regarding all the requirements and protocols to be followed.

## 4. COMPETITION REGULATIONS and OFFICIALS

### 4.1. Regulations

- The Championships will be organized based on IBA Technical & Competition Rules.
- The Official Draw will be conducted by IBA Approved Scoring System through an electronic draw.

### 4.2 Competition Officials

- This Championships is a Continental, IBA-sanctioned Event and will be officiated by IBA-certified International Technical Officials and IBA-certified 1-Star to 3-Star Referees & Judges.

## 5. EVENT SCHEDULE

### 5.1 Event Period

The event dates are , and the schedule will include the following:

**NOTE: The final schedule with dates and times will be decided accordingly with the Technical Delegate and LOC, and all Teams will be notified.**

TRAINING: Teams will be given a schedule for training times at the Official Training Venue. They will be allowed to train ONLY during the period that they have been assigned. The Schedule will be posted on the Information Board at Team Hotels & Coaches will be informed.

### 5.2 Training Camp

The training camp will take place 2 weeks before starting of the championships from 09.07 to 20.07.2025 in Zlatibor. Hotel Rates will be the same as during the Event Period. Please contact for further information and to make the necessary arrangements.

## 6. REGISTRATIONS

### 6.1 Boxers

#### Junior Boxers

Age Eligibility: Boxers born from January 01, 2011, to December 31, 2012. (Boxers who are 13 and 14 years old based on the year of birth)

Only one boxer per National Federation per weight category will be allowed to compete. National Federations may register a maximum of one main boxer and up to two reserve boxers for each of the weight categories listed below:

Schoolboys (16 weight categories) :

37–40kg, 42kg, 44kg, 46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 90kg.

Schoolgirls (13 weight categories) :

34–36kg, 38kg, 40kg, 42kg, 44kg, 46kg, 48kg, 51kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 64kg, 70kg

- All registrations must be done through the IBA database (<https://iba-database.sport/nf>)
- Entering reserve boxers in the database is strongly encouraged to allow an option of substituting boxers prior to the Sport Entries Check without penalties.

## **6.2 Team Officials**

Each Team Delegation can register the following number of Team Officials:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Doctor
- 1 Physiotherapist
- 1 IBA Certified Team Cut Technician
- Number of coaches according to the table below:
  - 1–3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches
  - 4–8 Boxers: Up to 7 Coaches
  - 9 – 13 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches
  - 13 – 26 Boxers: Up to 10 Coaches

### 6.2.1 Coaches

- Only IBA certified coaches (1, 2 or 3 star) can be registered as a Coach for this Championships. National Level coaches (not certified by IBA) are not allowed to serve as seconds and can only be registered as Extra Persons.

If your Team Delegation does not have an IBA Certified coach (1, 2 or 3 star), please raise this issue at the Technical Meeting, so arrangements can be made with another team.

- Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) coaches. However, only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.
- One of the 3 coaches can be replaced by an IBA Certified Team Cut Technician.

### 6.3 Extra Persons – Team official (to work with the team)

Each National Federation has the possibility to register **up to two** additional extra team officials. Extra Officials will have access to Team Stands and Training Venue, but will NOT have access to warm-up areas in the Competition Venue and will NOT be allowed to serve as seconds. Extra team officials must be accommodated in the team hotels in order to be accredited.

It is the responsibility of respective National Delegations to ensure that all Team Delegations Members hold the required certification and are qualified to perform their duties.

### 6.4 Extra Persons - National Federation Representatives (President, Secretary General, etc.) or VIPs

Each team must inform the LOC ([schoolboxing2024@gmail.com](mailto:schoolboxing2024@gmail.com)) and EUBC Office ([office@eubcboxing.org](mailto:office@eubcboxing.org)) about any national federation representatives or VIPS who will attend the Championships on behalf of the NF.

### 6.5 Process and deadlines

#### **Registration will open on July 20 2024**

## 6.6 Late registration fees

### **\*Important:**

National Federations dispatching Team Delegations are required to appoint an IBA 1-Star, 2-star or 3-star Referee & Judge and register the R&J via the IBA Database and also send the name of the candidate to EUBC Office at [office@eubcboxing.org](mailto:office@eubcboxing.org) no later than 15 July 2025. The list of the appointed Referees & Judges will be sent to EUBC Referee & Judge Committee for approval, and then further to IBA. In case of any issue regarding the R&J's appointment, EUBC will contact National Federations in order to appoint a replacement. **Please respect the deadline of providing the name of the nominated R&J.**

Please note, that EUBC has introduced a system of fines in order to support the organizers of Continental Championships and ensure timely submission of all registration information. EUBC encourages all National Federations to plan timely and diligently to avoid these fines.

Offence	Penalty Amount	Remarks
Late registration/replacement of a boxer	€ 200	Must be paid prior to Sport Entries Check
Late registration/replacement of a coach, team manager, doctor, cut technician, physio or R&J	€ 100	Must be paid prior to Sport Entries Check
Registration of a new boxer at the Sport Entries Check without any prior notice	€ 500	Must be paid prior to Sport Entries Check & confirmed by respective National Federation
Failure to appoint an appropriately certified R&J	€ 500	Applicable to Team Delegations with <b>three or more registered boxers</b> / Must be paid prior to Sport Entries Check

## 7. ACCREDITATIONS

All Team Delegation members registered for the event through the IBA Database within the deadline will receive their accreditations on site after the LOC has approved the accommodation payment.

Accreditations will be given out only upon presentation of a passport.

## 8. SPORT ENTRIES CHECK

The Sport Entries Check will take place on 22.July at Zlatibor. Please make sure to arrive to Zlatibor, Serbia, on or prior to 21 July. EUBC and LOC will inform Team Delegations of their exact appointment time prior to the event (the schedule will also be displayed at Team Delegation Information Desks). The Sport Entries Check is **mandatory** for all Team Delegations, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to attend their appointment on time.

Each Team delegation can appoint a maximum of 2 persons to attend the Sport Entries Check. EUBC recommends to each team to send the Team Manager and/or the Team Doctor and/or the Head Coach.

Each Team Delegation's representatives will have an appointment with the Officials to confirm the entry list of their delegation, the spelling of boxers' names, the uniforms, national flag and anthem and to present the official documents listed below.

Your representative(s) must present:

1. National Passports of each boxer.
2. Record Books of each boxer (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
3. Results of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV tests, not older than 6 months
4. IBA Medical certificates issued within the last 30 days for each boxer.
5. Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form for each female boxer, signed and dated
6. Anti-doping consent forms signed by each boxer.
7. Video consent form signed by team manager/head coach.
8. Code of Conduct Enforcement signed by team manager/head coach.
9. Boxer's uniform examples.

**To complete the Sport Entries process and receive accreditations, all Team Delegations must have fully paid the LOC for their accommodation.**

**The EUBC Office will send all Sport Entries Check forms to National Federations**

**IMPORTANT**

- Please note that the presence of your representative is mandatory. In the event where Team Delegation Representatives do not show-up to the scheduled appointment, the entire Team will be disqualified.







## 12. IMAGE RIGHTS & TECHNICAL VIDEO RECORDING

A Host Broadcaster will film promotional videos and official Championships photographers will take photos of boxers before and during the Championships. All training sessions will be open to the media unless a Team Delegation specifically requests otherwise. By participating in the Championships, each Team Delegation Member agrees to release his/her image rights to EUBC.

Video recording of bouts by Team Delegation Members for broadcasting purposes of any kind (including social media) will not be allowed.

National Federations may be allowed to record bouts of their boxers with not more than one camera per ring, exclusively for technical purposes. Specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose. Each National Federation must submit a signed copy of the Video Consent Form at the Sport Entries Check.

## 13. DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping controls will be conducted in accordance with the IBA Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code. We want to remind you that according to WADA regulations, from 2016, blood testing may be conducted during IBA Competitions.
